**Who We Are:**

For more than a century, Fred Finch Youth Center has served youth and their families in the East Bay. Today we also serve communities on the peninsula, in Solano County and San Diego County. Our clients include children, adolescents, and young adults who face varied and often multiple challenges. Many are transitioning from foster care into the adult world. Many have an emotional disturbance or mental illness. Some have both a mental illness and a developmental disability. All are economically impoverished. Most have experienced, abuse, neglect, trauma or lack of adequate health care or educational resources. To enhance the strengths and assist with the challenges of each individual, we provide a wide variety of services in several types of settings: specialty residential treatment; special education; vocational services; transitional housing; individual, group and family therapy and counseling. Services are provided in the community, in schools, in homes and at our sites.

**Position Summary:**

The Social Worker for the Crisis and Assessment program in Oakland is responsible for the overall clinical treatment, care and supervision of the resident.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Direct, develop, coordinate and maintain the mental health component of residents' treatment.
2. Provide individual, group and family therapy.
3. Conduct comprehensive biopsychosocial assessments.
4. Prepare initial and on-going treatment plans in coordination with all treatment team members; monitor treatment plan implementation and revision.
5. Provide clinical leadership, training and consultation to the treatment team.
6. Serve as community liaison and case manager for placement workers, professional and community resources, parents and significant others; keep parents and placement workers apprised of resident crises and program changes; act as liaison to provide continuity of care as needed.
7. Attend, facilitate and/or participate in all required treatment meetings, including treatment reviews, special staffings and IEP's.
8. Complete all paperwork, including treatment plans, progress notes, quarterly reports and discharge summaries, in a timely manner.
9. Participate, on a rotating basis, in providing clinical on-call and weekend coverage.
10. Perform all other duties as assigned.

**Requirements:**

1. Master's Degree in Social Work (MSW) or other social science discipline licensed or license eligible.
1. LCSW or MFT preferred.
2. Experience with developmentally disabled population preferred.
3. Experience with residential/milieu treatment of adolescents preferred.
