Inside the Comprehensive Classification and Compensation Study Process

In alignment with <u>our core values of equity and inclusion at Fred Finch</u>, the leadership team, with the full support of the Board of Directors, contracted the Gallagher Company to conduct a comprehensive Classification and Compensation Study, to help us develop and implement an equitable classification system that supports the work we do to achieve our mission and vision.

Commencing in 2022, the classification phase of the study involved a meticulous review of each role within the agency, seeking accurate and descriptive information about the work performed by our employees in every position. The overarching goals of this classification study were to:

- Develop a clear, consistent, and sustainable classification system that promotes internal and external equity
- Develop a career paths and foster career opportunities within our agency
- Attract and retain qualified individuals

Recently, the first phase of the compensation portion of the study concluded successfully, marking a significant milestone in our commitment to fair and equitable compensation, ensuring equity, fair pay, and sustainability for everyone involved.

This comprehensive study ensures that our employees are compensated fairly, aligning with a wage scale that considers similar roles within our organization and across the broader spectrum of nonprofit and for-profit entities. This strategic investment in our workforce is pivotal for maintaining competitiveness in recruiting and retaining talented individuals. It ensures that all positions are accurately categorized and compensated using a standardized scale, adhering to the best industry practices and promoting an equitable work environment for all.

The implementation of this equitable pay scale reinforces our resolve to fostering a workplace that values everyone, promotes equality, and supports the overall well-being of our staff. Empowering Futures: Fred Finch Board Approves Another Round of Degree Assistance Program (DAP) Funding!

At Fred Finch, our steadfast commitment to fostering the personal and professional growth of our valued employees takes center stage. This commitment is evident in one our most effective initiatives – the exceptional <u>Degree Assistance Program (DAP)</u>.

DAP offers employees the opportunity to apply for financial assistance for educational pursuits. With the unwavering support of our Board of Directors, who actively participate in interviews, selection and approvals, the program has had a tremendous success. This year, DAP has expanded its eligibility and qualifications beyond the clinical field, but also job-specific certifications and programs. To be eligible for assistance, an employee must have worked for Fred Finch/CARES for six months or more and received a satisfactory performance evaluation, reflecting our belief in the continuous professional development and upward mobility for every employee.

DAP is a crucial component of our 'Grow Our Own' strategy, designed to cultivate talent from within our organization. It mirrors our commitment to inclusivity, recruitment, and retention as we strive to attract a new generation of mental health workers and beyond.

DAP **provides financial scholarship support of up to \$10,000**. Over the years, DAP has transformed the lives of our dedicated employees, enabling them to give back to our participants and community while achieving their higher education goals.

Fred Finch CARES Introduces Enhanced Care Management (ECM) Program!

Fred Finch is excited to introduce our latest program, **Enhanced Care Management (ECM) Program**, operating under the umbrella of Fred Finch CARES. With a cross regional services delivery model in both Northern and Southern California, **ECM is a comprehensive care coordination benefit launched in July 2023 under CalAIM, focusing on children and youth in our communities.** This program adopts a Whole Person Care Approach to healthcare, delivering physical, behavioral, emotional, and social services to enhance care coordination and health outcomes, recognizing the crucial interplay of various factors.

Families enrolled in our ECM program undergo a thorough assessment, incorporating the Social Determinants of Health, allowing us to tailor our services to meet each family's unique needs. Each family is assigned a dedicated care manager, highly trained to provide a wide array of services, including care coordination, outreach and engagement, health promotion, comprehensive transitional care, linking families to services, advocacy, and access to resources. Our care managers serve as consistent support, guiding and educating participants and their families on navigating the continuum of care.

Under the leadership of **Senior Director, Dr. Cristobal Hernandez**, our ECM program is meticulously designed to meet children and youth precisely where they are, serving as a potential catalyst for positive change. As the program continues its rapid expansion, fueled by the unwavering dedication of our passionate team members committed to making a meaningful difference in the lives of our youth and their families, our goal intensifies. We aim not only to eliminate barriers faced by many families but also to seamlessly coordinate services for them. Our overarching objective is to widely disseminate this profoundly impactful program to as many qualifying children, youth, and families as possible, ensuring that it becomes a beacon of hope and support for communities across California and beyond.

Our team is inspired by the remarkable success stories and positive feedback we receive daily, illustrating the tangible impact of ECM. Through this program, we've connected families with crucial financial resources, facilitated access to healthcare, assisted with transportation, interpretation, and advocacy, coordinated comprehensive care, and even offered urgent supplies for families in need. These stories exemplify the transformative influence ECM has, making a genuine difference in the lives of those we serve.

Reflecting on the profound impact of the program, Dr. Hernandez expressed, "Being part of the ECM program, with a specific focus on children and youth, is an immense honor for me. I am motivated by the immediate impact it has on families within our communities. I genuinely believe that this is the driving force behind our ECM team's passion and commitment. Having grown up in a very rural part of California, where most families were agricultural field workers and predominantly monolingual Spanish speakers, I understand the challenges they face. Language, coupled with a lack of knowledge on accessing or advocating for resources, was a significant barrier. Our ECM program plays a crucial role in helping families overcome such barriers, and I take great pride in contributing to its success."

As the program gains momentum, ECM is making great strides across both regions, and we are thrilled about the positive changes it has brought so far, as well as the significant impact it is having on the lives of our participants and the community at large.
