Innovative Job Training Program for Youth with Developmental Disabilities


Last month, in honor of **Autism Awareness & Acceptance Month**, Fred Finch staff were excited to learn about an **innovative job training program** for youth with developmental disabilities and significant mental health challenges from our colleague, **Bret Calhoun**, **the Principal of our San Diego Nonpublic School**.

The success of this program is due to the exceptional talent of our faculty and leadership team at the **San Diego Dual Diagnosis Program**, who provide vital support to participants and their families, enabling them to succeed academically and develop functional skills through **real-world job training experiences.** The job training program is made possible through a partnership with the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR).

We are excited about the program's potential and its positive impact on the lives of our participants and the community.

The Contra Costa School-Based and Community Services Program Spotlight

The Contra Costa School-Based and Community Services (CC SBS/CS) program is a vital program at Fred Finch Youth & Family Services (FF) that provides accessible, community-based, and trauma-informed mental health services to students at school and in the community. Our program aims to improve school outcomes, enhance social and family relationships, and reduce the need for higher levels of care. In collaboration with Contra Costa County Behavioral Health and school districts (Mt. Diablo Unified and Antioch Unified), our highly trained and dedicated staff provide a range of services on public school campuses, including individual and family therapy, group therapy, consultation with educational staff, guidance on behavioral interventions, crisis support, case management, and treatment plan development.

Our program is also in partnership with John Muir Health (JMH) and the community agencies One Day at a Time (ODAT) and Center for Human Development (CHD) to provide clinical services, outreach and engagement services for clients of the JMH Beyond Violence program. Additionally, through our partnership with JMH, we provide telehealth therapy on Saturdays through the JMH Mobile Health Clinic.

According to the <u>John Muir Health 2021 Community Benefit Report</u>, this program is "a vital resource for students in Contra Costa County," and through the JMH partnership alone, FF staff served 120 individuals in 2021 to address a range of mental health needs. The program's impact on the lives of students, families, and the community is significant and positive, promoting mental and physical resiliency and wellness while providing comprehensive care for youth and families.
